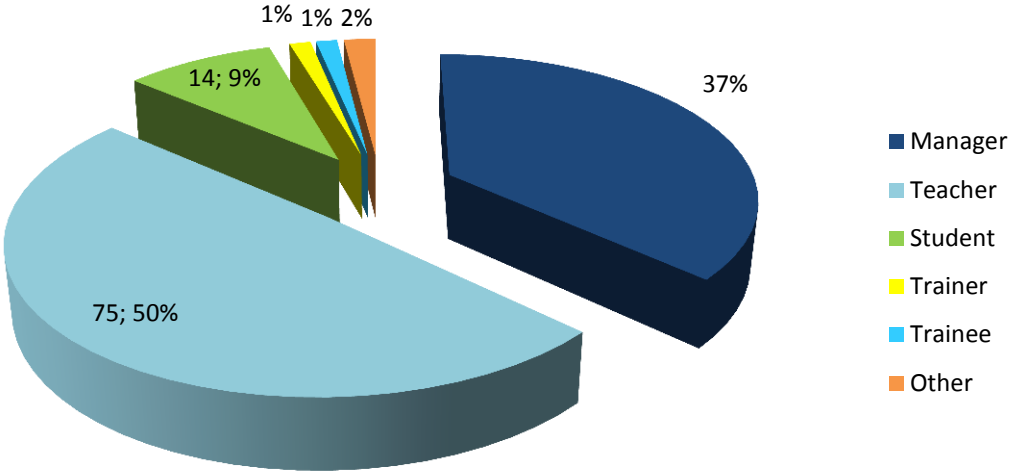

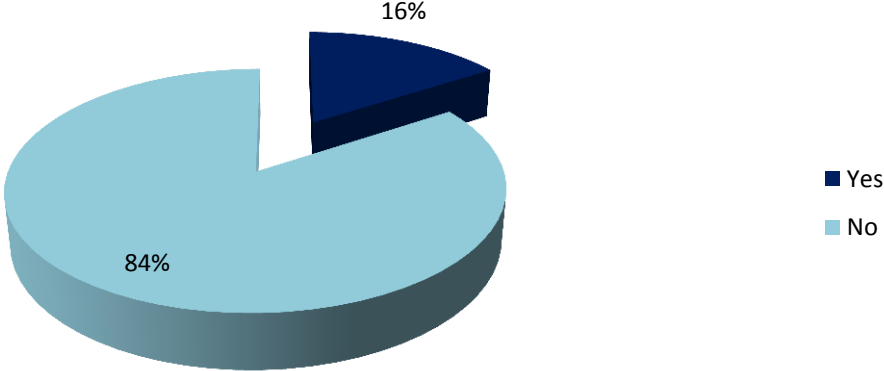

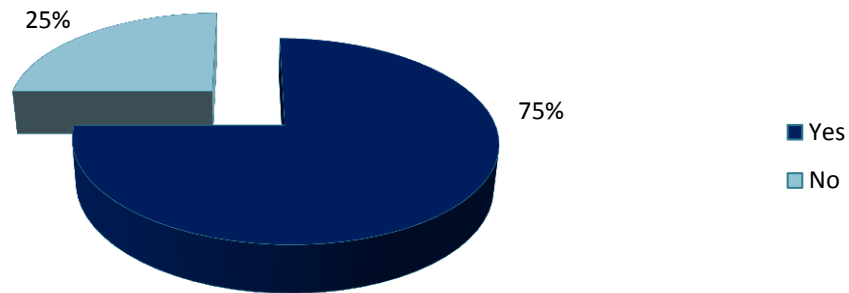
1- Target Group



2- Are you aware about the existence of Occupational Health and Safety Policies at EU level

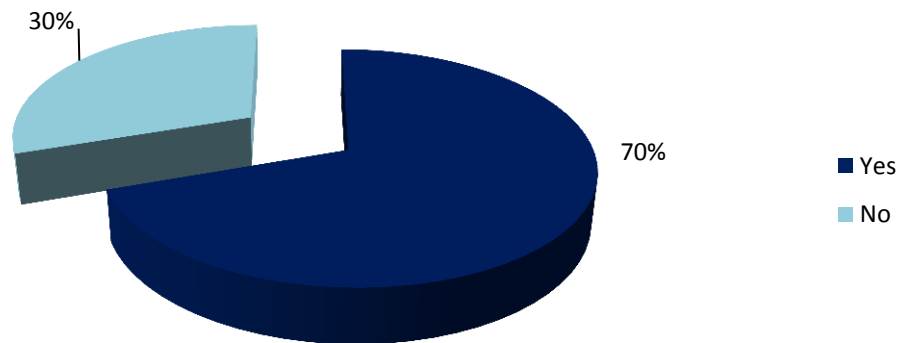


3- Can you list effective practices leading to successful implementations of the Occupational, Health and Safety regulations in your school/organization?



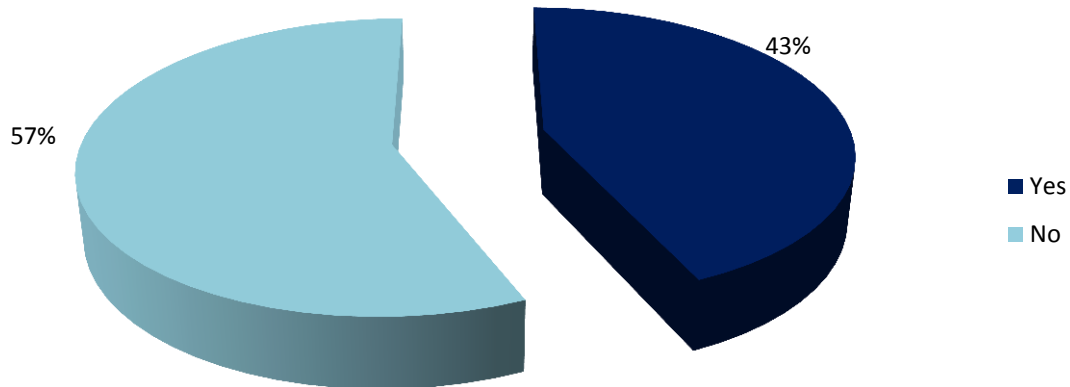
- Training courses, seminars, information meetings about OHS
