
In the meeting, Quarter Mediation provided the participants with a questionnaire with their expectations regarding the project.



2. What impact do you expect to be achieved for the staff and learners from your organization involved in the project, in terms of increasing language skills, ICT skills, social and vocational skills?




3. In your opinion, how useful will the project outcomes be for the organizations acting at local, regional and/or national level in your country?



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
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4. What are the strong and the weak points of the project in terms of the type of the organization approved to be involved in the project?

Strong points:

- To find a common solution of a common problem
- To have partners with experience in projects, so as to help other partners who are less experienced
- We can work effectively as we are only 3 partners.
- We can quickly come to agreements, adjustments.
- We are a few members, but a lot of questions
- the fact that the partners involved in the project have years of experience in mobility projects within the framework of the LLP program Leonardo da Vinci and others EU projects and this of course give contribution to the project with important competences and skills.
- each partner already collaborate with a large number of hosting companies
- The focus on relation between intermediary partners and hosting companies is quite innovative and the partner organizations have expertise on the issue



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- The project raises the interest of companies in participation in management and planning issues and it will be possible within the partners to reach a high number of hosting institutions

Weak points:

- The number of the organizations approved in the project is very low (3 from a total of 8 in the application form).
- Many tasks to do on fewer partners.
- from 8 partners we are just 5
- risk to lose the focus on the project's aim
- The easiness with which we can lose focus among so many other projects and having lost 3 partners
- The motivation to participate and achieve results can be variable within the group and project lifetime
